New Pick Up Location and Delivery Option

The basic of our new program

Our new market CSA program to allows you more choices compared to our passed standard box CSA. Our market CSA program is point based system. Each size share will have a standard point value for week of the season. Each week the CSA member will be given a list of produce that have points value given to each item based on what is in season. The member then chooses from the items from their list to meet their point value. We the farmers will have a few free items each week that will be adding to your box that we would like you to try in addition to what you pick. If you are a drop box you will receive an email 4 days prior to pick with a list of produce available for you for the week. You will have 2 days to fill out the email and return it. If email is not received, we will make you a standard box based on the weeks produce. If you are picking up at the farmer's market you will be emailed a list four days prior to market with what will be at market and the point value of each item. At the market each item will have the CSA value marked and you can pick your item that you want based on your points.

The sizes of our Box

We have a single, couple, and family share. Each share size will have a different point value. A single share will have 10 to 12 points for the week, a couple share will have 15 to 18 points a week, a family share will have 20 to 24 points a week.

Cost of Basket

Family Share - \$600

Couple Share- \$375

Single Share- \$250

Egg Share- One dozen Free Range eggs added to you basket each week - \$40
